1 SUPPORT MEMBER PRIORITIES & PRIMARY CARE SYSTEM

- Dr. Rob Baker and Ania Zubrowska, **won the People's Choice Award** at the Joint Collaborative Committees Conference for their storyboard showcasing the work on Addictions Medicine - Incentivizing Engagement and Recovery: A Contingency Management Pilot.
- **41 people attended** the Non-Pharmacological Approaches to Chronic Pain education event with the evaluation confirming a greater understanding of pain services.
- On Dec. 5th, 2025, the Division's Executive Director, Board Chair, and Vice-Chair (Katherine Brown, Dr. Meghan MacDonald, and Dr. Graham Dodd) met with Sylvia Weir, **Interior Health CEO** to discuss provider recruitment, maternity care, and Primary Care Networks in the Thompson Region.
- **3,500 Health Connect Registry (HCR) patients** were attached during Q3 and 63% of providers have now completed their PAS panel profiles.
- Launched **in-person services at PCN Health Hub**, including counselling and social work appointments, and comprehensive RN intake assessments.
- **Secured \$130K in funding** to support three new initiatives: Shared Care Older Adults Sustainability; FPSC Cultural Safety and Humility; and Shared Care Addictions Medicine.
- The **Eating Disorder project** hosted an educational session for parents & guardians of School District 73 to increase awareness of youth eating disorders.

- Hosted the festive **Thompson Region Division Winter Social** with 30 attendees including Division members, staff and community partners.
- The Division successfully coordinated the delivery of a two-day **Advances in Labour and Risk Management course** to 26 low-risk maternity care providers, which was funded by the RIH Afternoon Auxiliary. Attendees were grateful to attend education close to home.
